Relevant City Ordinances:

Sec. 22-71. Yard Sales. Subject to the limitations set out in this article, yard sales may be conducted in any residential zone in the city. (Code 1972, 13-21)

Sec. 22-72. Definition . As used in this article, the term "yard sale" shall include any sale by an individual of his or his family's clothes, household goods, and other items of personalty, conducted in a residential zone. (Code 1972, 13-21a)

Sec.22-73. **Permit Required.** No yard sale shall be conducted without first obtaining a permit from the city manager who shall issue this such permit for a fee as set forth in the schedule of fees and charges on file in the office of the city manager. The application for the permit shall be in the name of the person who will be conducting the sale and the permit shall state the name of the applicant, whether the sale is to be held jointly with anyone else, the dates the sale is to be conducted and the residential address of the location of the sale. (Code 1972, 13-21b)

Sec. 22-74. Location, duration of number of sales. All yard sales must be conducted from the residential premises of the applicant, except that it shall be permissible, for other residents of the city to participate with the applicant in a joint sale provided that the application shall identify the other participants and the permit issued for the joint sale. No individual shall be allowed a permit to conduct or participate in more than two yard sales in a calendar year and no such sales shall last more than two consecutive days. All yard sales shall be conducted in daylight hours. (Code 1972, 13-21c)

Sec. 22-272. Posting bills, other advertising matter. It shall be unlawful for any person to post any bills or other advertising matter on any place where he has not secured the permission of the owner or manager of the property to do so. (Code 1972, 13-131)
