Public Works Director is responsible for various administrative and managerial duties, such as monitoring and overseeing the physical facilities of the Pelham community. Additionally, to create and plan long-term programs that will develop the growth of a community. The Director is responsible for analyzing and assessing proposals. After evaluating the target proposals, a public works director should then present the top plans to designated department heads for consideration and then supervise and direct his staff to work on the chosen projects.

6. Strong communication skills.

7. Knowledge in safe work practices.
8. Ability to plan, organize and direct the work of public works personnel.
9. Ability to analyze organizational and administrative problems, recommend alternative courses of action, and provide leadership to others in implementing such actions.
