#### **CITIZEN COMMENTS**

Christi Dixon with the Georgia Department of Public Health gave updates on the COVID 19 and how to keep citizens and employees safe. Dixon stated that all restaurants were required to close indoor or outdoor dining. No one can congregate in all one place with more than 10 people and those people will need to be at least six feet apart.

Jamie Sullivan the Emergency Management Director of Mitchell County which has a vital role in coordinating the State response efforts to the local community. Sullivan stated the county signed an ordinance to get FEMA and GEMA process going so reimbursements can be given to be able to get PPE (personal protective equipment) in this community. Sullivan stated a local state of emergency has been declared. The Emergency Management team is available to help coordinate any local needs.

The city council gave a recommendation of confidence in moving forward with the Amended Declaration of Local Emergency and Executive Order of the Mayor of the City of Pelham.
