REGULAR SESSION **MAYOR TUCKER PRESIDING**

APPROVAL OF REGULAR MEETING AGENDA

Council Member Eubanks made a motion to approve the agenda as written, seconded by Council Member Brown. The vote was unanimous.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The vote was unanimous.**
